The Basics



Answer or end a call	Tap the Call $^{(\!\mathbb{C}\!)}$ button.
Adjust the volume	Tap the Volume button $ ightarrow$ to cycle through preset levels.
Mute	While on an active call, press and hold the Volume button () for 2 seconds. You hear "mute on" or "mute off."
Redial	To call your last number dialed, double tap the Call button ${\Bbb S}.$
Voice dial (phone feature)	Press the Call button \textcircled{C} for 2 seconds, wait for the phone prompt and then tell the phone to dial the name of a stored contact.
Toggle Voice Prompt On/Off	When the headset is powered on and you are not on a call the voice prompts can be turned off by pushing the volume Φ button and the call \mathbb{G} button for more than 4 seconds.
